Fifth Avenue Committee, Inc. (FAC) is a nationally recognized South Brooklyn based, non-profit comprehensive community development corporation and NeighborWorks America, Hispanic Federation and National Association of Latino Community Asset Builders (NALCAB) member formed in 1978 whose mission is to advance economic, social, and racial justice in New York City through integrated, community-centered affordable housing, grassroots organizing, policy advocacy and transformative education, training and services that build the power to shape our community's future. FAC works to transform the lives of thousands of low- and moderate-income New Yorkers annually so that we can all live with dignity and respect while making our community more equitable, sustainable, inclusive and just.

To achieve our mission, FAC develops and manages affordable housing and community facilities, creates economic opportunities and ensures access to economic stability, organizes tenants and residents around issues of housing, environmental justice and accountable development, and provides student centered adult education. In addition to our grassroots neighborhood work, we are actively involved in broader coalitions and campaigns.

FAC's Community Services department screens and connects over 1,000 low-and-moderate income New Yorkers annually with benefits, entitlements, financial coaching, legal and community health services. Additionally, the Resident Social Services Manager and Case Manager, within the Community Services team, provides case management services and housing stability supports to formerly homeless tenants living in affordable housing that FAC or a partner owns and manages. The Clinical Supervisory Consultant will

provide clinical supervision and support to the Resident Social Services Manager and Case Manager to promote best practices as FAC expands its resident services.

Responsibilities:

- Provide clinical supervision, support and guidance to the Resident Social Services Manager and Case Manager serving formerly homeless tenants living in FAC owned affordable housing, ensuring the staff meet program objectives and maintain social work best practices.
- Support the staff's ongoing development and implementation of a clinical framework for screening, engaging, and supporting residents with severe and persistent mental illnesses, a history or risk of homelessness, history or risk of substance use, and/or a history or risk with abusive relationship(s) and other needs.
- Support the staff in the thorough assessment of each resident and in developing service plans based on those assessments.
- Recommend and connect the Resident Social Services Manager with relevant professional development opportunities.

Qualifications:

- Must be a Licensed Master or Clinical Social Worker in New York State
- Minimum 3 years of relevant experience as a social work or clinical supervisor in residential settings for formerly homeless individuals or families with special needs.
- Knowledge of New York City's affordable housing and rent-stabilized housing regulations, behavioral and mental health systems and supports, and social services.
- Excellent interpersonal, listening, written, and verbal communication skills
- Understanding of the historical racism and disenfranchisement impacting BIPOC and formerly homeless New Yorkers, particularly those served by FAC.
